Life after Graduation John Brown University



Career-Ready Students

It's common to be concerned about life after graduation. At JBU, partnering with students to meet their goals is a priority, resulting in graduates with a high-success rate for finding post-graduate careers at an accelerated rate. We gauge our success using survey data collected from recent JBU graduates, known as The First Destination Survey.

Data included in the brochure is from August 2022, December 2022 and May 2023. The survey was administered to prospective graduates from JBU's traditional undergraduate (TUG), online undergraduate (OLUG) and graduate (GR) programs by JBU Career Development regarding future employment and education plans. In 2022-23, there were 281 TUG graduates, 49 OLUG graduates and 158 GR graduates.


JBU Graduate Career Success

Knowledge rate: 99%. Each respondent was counted only once. Knowledge rate: the percentage of graduates' postgraduate career activities the institution has information about as defined by National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). This information is gathered from multiple sources, including student responses, social media, JBU faculty/staff and National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). Response rate: the number of graduates who answered the question divided by the number of graduates. The response rate varies from question to question.



Are they where they want to be?


