Survey Methodology

The JBU Career Development Center surveyed all prospective JBU graduates using the JBU First Destination Survey, which reports future employment and education plans. This document summarizes the survey analysis given to graduates from August 2021, December 2021, and May 2022. The survey was administered to prospective graduates from JBU's traditional undergraduate (TUG), online undergraduate (OLUG), and graduate (GR) programs. In 2021-22, there were 278 TUG graduates, 57 OLUG graduates, and 166 GR graduates.

Definitions

The **knowledge rate** is the percentage of graduates the institution has information about their postgraduate career activities. This information is gathered from multiple sources, including student responses, social media, JBU faculty/staff, and National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). The National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) defines this definition.

The **landed rate** (also called Career Outcomes Rate by NACE) is the number of students employed, volunteering, in the military, or continuing their education divided by the number of students whose career activities are known.

The **response rate** is used for all other survey questions and is calculated as the number of graduates who answered the question divided by the number of graduates. The response rate varies from question to question.






